


Create a wiki space


1. On the front page of Wiki.nus, click **Create Space** or **Create a wiki**.

2. Give your space a **Space Name**. This is the wiki space's title. It can be changed later.

3. Give your space a **Space Key**. This forms part of the URL (web address) of your wiki space.




A yellow warning box with a warning icon at the top left. The title is "Space Key" with a warning icon. The text inside the box lists three requirements:
